


# The Elliott House Inn



## South of Broad Trail

### 1. St. John the Baptist Church *120 Broad Street*

The first church on site was The Cathedral of St. John and St Finbar. It was destroyed by Charleston great fire of 1861. The current structure was built in 1907, with the addition of the steeple in 2010.

### 3. Pineapple Gate House *14 Legare Street*

Constructed in 1800 and later added as a National Historic Landmark, the Pineapple Gates are most famous for symbolizing "Southern Hospitality".

### 2. Swords Gate House *32 Legare Street*

Most famous for the Swords woven throughout the ironwork of its gate. These gates were manufactured by Christopher Werner. The Swords Gate House was at one time used as a school for female education.

### 4. St. Michael's Episcopal Church *71 Broad Street*

The oldest church structure in Charleston. Pew 43 is known for George Washington, Robert E. Lee, Princess Diana & Prince Charles sitting there. John Rutledge & Charles Pinckney were buried here.
